
SUBJECT: VFR Aircraft Conducting Practice Instrument Approaches

VFR aircraft conducting practice instrument approaches at Anchorage International Airport, Merrill Field Airport and Elmendorf Air Force Base will be provided Standard IFR separation at the time the approach clearance is issued.

Aircraft requesting practice instrument approaches should contact Anchorage Approach Control on frequency 119.1/363.2 or 118.6/290.5 when approaching from the north and 126.4 or 123.8/257.9 when approaching from the south.
