FAIRBANKS AIRPORT TRAFFIC CONTROL TOWER LETTER TO AIRMEN NO. 07-1

SUBJECT: VFR aircraft conducting practice instrument approaches

CANCELLATION: April 12, 2009

VFR aircraft conducting practice instrument approaches at Fairbanks International Airport, Eielson Air Force Base, and Ladd Army Airfield will be provided Standard IFR separation at the time the approach clearance is issued. Except for heavy aircraft/B757, 500 feet vertical separation may be applied between VFR aircraft and between a VFR and an IFR aircraft.

Aircraft requesting practice instrument approaches should contact Fairbanks Approach Control on frequency 125.35/363.2 when approaching from the west and 126.5/381.4 when approaching from the east.
